Course Description

The goal of the proseminar is two-fold: (1) to introduce PhD students to the breadth and depth of scholarly research happening in the Management Division, and (2) to provide a weekly forum where students can learn about the process of producing scholarship more generally. Each week, a faculty member in organizational behavior, organizational theory, or strategy will present some of their current work and hold a 'behind the scenes' discussion of the research production process. This course is required for first-year Management PhD students, and is a great opportunity to get to know faculty and the state of the field through research.

All students are expected to attend and actively participate in class. Active participation requires (1) that students print-out and read the article(s) posted to our course Canvas site *before* class each week, and (2) that they come prepared to ask questions and engage in discussion with the visiting professor and your classmates.
